- Piano:** Enters in the 4th measure with a melodic line. Chord symbols "C-107", "BbMaj7", "G-7", "D7sus", and "CMaj7" are written below the staff in measures 10-14.
- Drum Set:** Enters in the 4th measure with a steady eighth-note pattern. A rehearsal mark "ECM STR EIGHTHS BALLAD. USE STICKS." is placed below the staff in measure 4.
